Overview

Community School of the Arts (CSA) is a non-profit arts education organization serving children and youth in the visual and performing arts. CSA provides high-quality instruction in music, theatre, dance, and visual art to children and youth of all ages and levels. The ideal candidate will have experience building and working in a musical theatre program with strong skills in musical theatre choreography. The candidate must be able to recruit and teach students from very young through high school. In addition, the candidate will have experience working with parents. The candidate will have a background in theatre with emphasis in musical theatre and choreography. Experience in teaching voice a plus. The Assistant Director will possess excellent communication and leadership skills and will serve alongside the Director of the theatre program. The Director and Assistant Director will be the face of the program. The candidate will also have the opportunity to develop dance classes for a variety of ages. The candidate must be able to network with the community and identify potential families for the program.
