

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Updated 2023

Please read before completing the application!

If a student drops mid semester, class or production, the scholarship must be paid back in full.

Community School of the Arts will award a limited number of scholarships, based on availability of funds. Scholarships are provided to assist students or students who demonstrate financial need. All prior scholarships and other financial aid already awarded will be taken into consideration when determining eligibility.

I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Recipients of the institutional scholarship are required to:

- Maintain satisfactory artistic talent
- Have and maintain a satisfactory attendance record at rehearsals, lessons, and performances
- US citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Not be related to any CSA faculty, staff, or board member

II. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Complete and submit a scholarship application with the items listed below

- Teacher Recommendation
- Student Questionnaire
- Parent Questionnaire
- Registration form for the class(es) you wish to participate in
- Registration fee associated with each class to be taken (\$25 minimum)
 - Private lesson
 - o Ensemble or Group class
 - Theatre Production

III. SELECTION RECIPIENTS

Selections will be based on student's overall artistic talent, attendance, and financial need.

IV. NOTICE OF AWARDS

Students will be notified by email of any scholarship award or denial.

V. RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships may be renewed on a semester-by-semester basis, contingent upon satisfactory artistic talent, attendance, and availability of funds. Students must re-apply by the deadline for the semester for a continuation of the scholarship; scholarships do not roll over or re-instate automatically. The deadline to apply for a scholarship is one week prior to the class start date each semester.

VI. REVOCATION OF AID

CSA reserves the right to cancel any scholarship aid awarded at any time if the applicant fails to meet the standards of academic progress, any other scholarship requirements, fails to follow all CSA policies, or falsifies information reported. Scholarships are not available for the summer semester. If a student drops mid semester, class or production, the scholarship must be paid back in full.
